Welcome to Jyväskylä, the Capital of Sport!

Jyväskylä has in its city strategy expressed a strong will to be Finland's Capital of Sport. This means that we are consciously working towards offering the best expertise and conditions for the physical activity of our residents and athlete guests.

Welcome to Jyväskylä for Running and Enjoyment!

The Masters Athletes' European Marathon Championship (EMAMRC) will take place in Jyväskylä on September 6, 2025. The competition will be held alongside the traditional Finlandia Marathon on the scenic Rantaraitti trail in Jyväskylä. The start and finish areas are located at Lutakonaukio, a square near the city center designed for major events. The competition hub will be adjacent to the square at Jyväskylä Pavilion.

The route circles the beautiful and natural surroundings of Lake Jyväsjärvi. It is wide enough, free from major hills or tricky corners, making it a highly runnable and fast course. The temperature in early September in Finland is also ideal for marathon running.

Hosting EMAMRC alongside the Finlandia Marathon ensures a high-quality environment, seamless organization, excellent services, and an encouraging atmosphere. For those accompanying the marathon runners, there are also opportunities to participate in the Finlandia Five or Valonkymppi runs on Friday, or the Half Marathon on Saturday.

Finland's nature, with its thousands of lakes, is stunning in early September, and the beginning of autumn foliage adds vibrant colors to the landscape. International competitors will surely experience the unique northern charm. Jyväskylä offers an incredible combination of pure nature and urban experiences both during and beyond the race.

There is a wide range of accommodation options near the event center, with prices very competitive by European standards. Traveling from Finland's capital, Helsinki, to Jyväskylä is convenient and takes about three hours by train or bus, with picturesque views along the way. There are also approximately three daily flights between Helsinki and Jyväskylä.

Welcome to the Capital of Sport in Finland, Jyväskylä

City of Jyväskylä is known from its education, wellbeing, clean nature, and safe cozy atmosphere. Jyväskylä is an active city of sports and events.

Jyväskylä (population 150 000) is located in the middle of Lakeland Finland and is part of the largest unbroken lake district in the Europe.

“The big little city” accurately describes Jyväskylä. It has the advantages of a small town, such as comfort, safety and short distances, but offers a broad variety of services. All services like hotels and restaurants, are within walking distance from marathon venue, Rantaraitti.

Jyväskylä is known as the Capital of Sport in Finland, with numerous sporting events and endless opportunities for exercise. There are several hiking trails in the area, such as the Laajavuori nature trails and the popular jogging route, Jyväsjärvi Rantaraitti, which circles the beautiful lake. The Rantaraitti is also the venue for the EMA European Marathon Championships.



What other fun things can you do in Jyväskylä?

Jyväskylä is an active cultural city, especially known as the hometown of the world-famous architect Alvar Aalto. There are a total of 29 buildings designed by Alvar Aalto in the Jyväskylä area, and the Aalto2 Museum is well worth a visit. There are also several other museums in the city. In summer, cruise ships take you around some of Jyväskylä's most beautiful lakescapes. Jyväskylä is also a sauna town, with excellent sauna facilities, for example at [Sataman Viilu](#), or at [Savutuvan Apaja](#).

How do I get to Jyväskylä?

International participants should arrive in Finland at Helsinki-Vantaa or Tampere airport. For information on a wide range of international flights to Helsinki-Vantaa airport, check [more information from here](#). Both airports have good train and bus connections to Jyväskylä. From Helsinki-Vantaa International Airport, there are two connections a day to Jyväskylä and the flight takes about 50 minutes. Jyväskylä Airport is located a 20-minute drive from the city centre. By train or bus, the journey from Helsinki to Jyväskylä takes about 3h 30 minutes. Buses and trains to Jyväskylä arrive several times a day, with an average of 19 trains a day. Both arrive at Jyväskylä Matkakeskus, which is located right in the city centre.

Where to stay?

In Jyväskylä there are 11 hotels and numerous Airbnb and hostel options. In total, there are around 1500 hotel rooms in the city, also at affordable prices. All hotels in Jyväskylä are in an excellent location in the city centre, within walking distance of to the competition venue, Rantaraitti.

TEAM COMPETITION

- In the team competition, medals will be awarded to the top three teams in each age category.
- Teams consist of three members, with their times added together. The team competition results are determined by the sum of the times of the first three athletes from each country, provided they are in the same age category.
- If there are three or more runners in the same age category (Natural Team), no team registration is required, as the team is automatically formed by the results of the top three runners.
- If a team consists of athletes from three different age categories (Composed Team), the team will be placed in the category of the youngest member of the team. In this case, team registration is mandatory.
- If there is a Natural Team in one category, it cannot be formed Composed Team.
- A runner can participate in only one team.
- If two teams have the same score, the better is the one whose first competitor has a better result.
- Team registration must be done by the Team Leaders at the Event Center in Jyväskylä Pavilion on Friday, September 5 by 6:00 PM

NON-EMA PARTICIPANTS

Participation is allowed.

If successful, athletes will receive a certificate for their performance, but will not be awarded a European Championship medal.

PROTESTS AND APPEALS

- Protest concerning the result or conduct of an event shall be made within 60 minutes of the official announcement of the result of that event.
- Any protest shall be made orally to the Referee by an athlete, by someone acting on behalf or by an official representative of a team.
- Any appeal must be submitted in writing to the Jury of Appeal, along with the amount of € 100 (one hundred euros) in the TIC.
- The money will be returned if the appeal is accepted.

EVENT VENUE

Jyväskylä Pavilion – Trade and Congress Center

Bib pickup, changing rooms, and gear storage will be located at Jyväskylä Pavilion, which is situated near the Jyväskylä city center.

Jyväskylä Pavilion is one of Finland's largest event centers, hosting nearly 700 events annually. It also serves as the event hub for the Finnish round of the World Rally Championship.

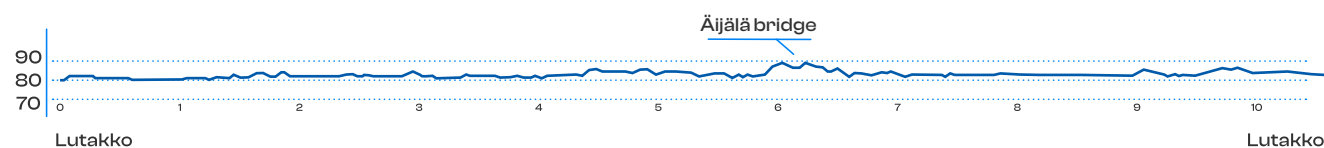
ROUTE
